ALTER- *With God's help, next time I will ...instead of...*



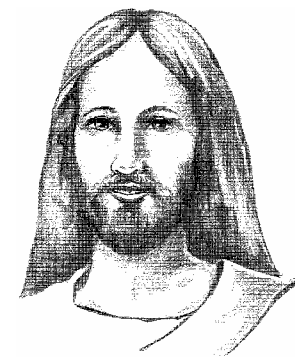
