Luke 2:10-14

1. The Purpose of the Savior

a. He will bring salvation for all (Luke 1:68, 69, 71, 77; 2:10, 30, 38)

But just what does salvation mean?

b. The difference between DO & DONE (Luke 2:10)

Religion = DO

Relationship = DONE

2. The Person of the Savior

a. He is Perfect: The Christ (Luke 1:35; 2:11, 26)

He is the Perfect sacrifice for sin (Heb. 9:26; 10:10, 12)

He is the Perfecter of our faith (Heb. 12:2)

He is the Perfect intercessor for us (Heb. 25)

b. He is all Powerful: The Lord (Luke 1:32, 33, 43; 2:11)

He is a King (Luke 1:32, 33)

His Kingdom is eternal (Luke 1:33)


He is a King we will all someday bow to (Phil. 2:8-11)
