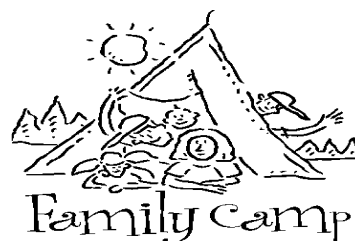

June 28 Congregational Meeting

Recommendation #1 from the Trustees on how to spend the remaining money from the sale of the parsonage passed. The following is a list of the improvements approved by the congregation:

1. Improvements to the Missions Center to include insulation in the ceiling and south wall, lighting, additional carpeting, new ceiling, etc.
2. Improvements to the sound system in the Crossroads Ministry Center including sound panels.
3. A new video projector/screen system in CMC.
4. Improvements to the lighting in the CMC.
5. Improvements to the water system and restroom fixtures near the Sanctuary.
6. New heating boiler for the Missions Center.

Recommendation #2: The Trustees were asked to negotiate an extension of the time limit of an option to purchase twenty (20) acres just east of the existing church property. Upon written confirmation of same, the Church would accept contributions designated for the purchase of this land.

Needed: A parent of Bluffton Elementary child/children, to be Ebenezer's Weekday Christian representative for the 2009/2010 school year. Duties are to find willing walkers from Ebenezer to walk the elementary age classrooms from the school to the First Mennonite Church for a 30 minute time of Christian Education. The Ebenezer representative is responsible for finding walkers for three days a week, once a month, during the school year. This is a great opportunity to get to know your child/children's friends and become familiar with the Weekday Christian Education program.
